Fundraising/Club Support

A Fundraising fee of \$500* is charged to all Senior/Masters and Junior members to help with the cost of maintaining clubhouse facilities and equipment. The \$500 is reimbursed from the Membership fee if a member makes themselves available a minimum of 6 times during the membership year for on-site support at Cricket, AFL, Soccer and V8 Supercar events in Tasmania. Members may arrange a replacement to undertake their commitment if they are unable to do so. All other members are not required to volunteer, however it is encouraged and greatly appreciated.

ALL Members are required to help maintain the Club equipment and facilities, both by careful use during training and competition, and by participating in organised work sessions during the Season.

Communication

The NERC provides a range of communication options (Facebook, email, website) to help build healthy relationships within the Club. It is important that contact details provided on your membership form are correct, and if they change, the NERC is notified.

Insurance

All members must complete a Rowing Tasmania Registration Form and pay the applicable fee (approx. \$85 rowers and \$30 non rowers). The registration fee ensures members are covered by insurance at sanctioned events and includes coverage for training and travelling to these events.

Race Fees

Members are charged a seat fee for every race entered throughout the racing season. These fees vary depending on the type of regatta (ie Pennant, State and National) and are set by the organising body. They are payable to the NERC prior to competition in any regatta. The NERC reserves the right to withhold race entries if fees from a previous regatta are outstanding.

Club Equipment

Members may be liable for the cost of repairing club equipment damaged as a result of negligent behaviour and/or failure to abide by club rules and policies.

Club Uniform

All persons competing at regattas as a member of the NERC are required to wear the club rowing uniform (approximately \$70 per suit). These can be ordered direct from Simply Oarsome at <http://www.oarsome.com.au/>

Club Access

Members (excluding juniors) may apply to the Committee for a key to the Boatshed. The Committee reserves the right to limit the number of keys available, and to prioritise key allocation to those members with the greatest need for independent access. Key holders are required to undertake training in and comply with Club security procedures or forfeit their right to hold a key. A \$50 bond is payable.
